### Course Details

The course comprises 3 Modules. The first 2 Modules are worth 30 credits with the Final Project worth 60 credits.

### Study

Part-time, online distance learning through our Virtual Learning Studio (VLS). Most students will take approximately 12-18 months to complete this course.



### Who should do this course?

Anyone who is serious about becoming an interior designer who has an existing Foundation Degree or HND (or equivalent) in a relevant design subject may top-up to BA (Hons) Design for Outdoor Living. This top-up degree gives you the opportunity to gain a qualification in two distinct disciplines of interior design.

Mature students with extensive experience in the Interior Design profession can also receive recognition through this qualification.

This Degree is validated and awarded by Staffordshire University. If you have to juggle family commitments, full-time or part-time work and want the flexibility offered by studying part-time by distance learning, then this is the course for you.
